During the Borough Council meeting on November 5, 2012 the following actions were taken:

- 1. Margot Kelley was appointed through Resolution 2012-34 as Edgewood Borough's 2012-2013 Junior Councilperson by Council and sworn in by Mayor Ed Cook.
- A motion was made and passed to join the Turtle Creek Valley Council of Governments (COG)
 Vacant and Blighted Property partnership. \$300.00 participation fee disbursement was
 approved.
- The motion to award bid to sale a 1987 Ford Explorer was rescinded and a corrected motion (model year is 1997) to advertise for sale and receive bids on a 1997 Ford Explorer was made and passed.

Reports were heard from the Edgewood Volunteer Fire Department, the Edgewood Foundation, CC Mellor Library Board representative, and Water Authority representative.

Borough Council representatives attended the COG PennDOT traffic mitigation project meeting, the RSCA PennDot traffic mitigation meeting and are working with local elected Borough representatives through the COG and CONNECT on a letter expressing our concerns on the negative impact on our communities.

Borough representatives will attend an Inter-borough Recreation meeting to discuss possibilities in joint inter-municipal recreation programs.
