Council Action Notes (CAN)

January 7, 2013

During the Borough Council meeting on January 7, 2013 the following actions were taken:

1. A motion was passed authorizing payment of bills for goods and services received by the Borough, on the bill list dated December 31, 2012 from the General Fund in the amount of \$23,515.27 and from the Sewer Fund in the amount of \$2,586.88 for a total of \$26,102.15; and on the bill list dated January 7, 2013 from the General Fund in the amount of \$116,399.10 and from the Sewer Fund in the amount of \$962.10 for a total of \$117, 361.20.
2. Resolution 2013-01 was approved reappointing Mr. Stephen Zelenko to the Zoning Hearing Board.
3. The 2013 Tax Ordinance 1041 had its first and second reading. This ordinance, if passed on January 22, 2013, will set the tax rate for the Borough of Edgewood at the rate of 5.650 mills on each \$1000.00 of assessed value. This makes the 2013 budget *revenue neutral*, and indicates no tax increase for 2013. Assessment appeals are still being heard.
4. A motion to advertise the 2013 Tax Ordinance 1041, setting the millage at 5.650, for public review was passed.
5. The motion was passed to hire Joseph Tomko as a Full Time Police Officer contingent on passing the physical and psychological examinations and background check. Officer Tomko was first on the Civil Service List, is a veteran, was interviewed by the Public Safety Committee and has been a Part Time Officer for the Borough of Edgewood.
6. Council accepted the resignation of Part Time Officer Christopher Burns.
7. A motion was passed approving a four year lease agreement with Ricoh for two copiers for the Borough at a monthly cost of \$348.94. This is under PA State Contract 4600013235 and includes maintenance and toner. It is slightly less than the previous lease.
8. Reports were heard on Recreation regarding the beginning of Basketball and the Library (Mayor Cook).

The Congress of Neighboring Communities (CONNECT) will meet on Thursday, January 17<sup>th</sup> at the Swissvale Fire Station.
