Council Action Notes (CAN)

April 1, 2013

During the Borough Council Meeting on April 1, 2013 the following actions were taken:

1. A motion was passed authorizing the payment of bills, for goods and services received by the Borough, from the General Fund in the amount of \$63,854.73 and from the sewer fund in the amount of \$44,889.33, for a total of \$108,744.06.
2. A motion was passed to accept the high bid from Chicago Motors, Inc. for the sale of a 2008 Ford Crown Victoria in the amount of \$3,107.00.
3. A motion was passed to approve the application of the Western Pennsylvania School for the Deaf for conditional use for the construction of a new dormitory based on the favorable recommendation of the Borough Planning Commission dated March 5, 2013.
4. A motion was passed to accept the highest bid of McDonald's USA for the sale of Parcel D in the amount of \$600,000.00 and to execute the agreement of sale with McDonald's USA as presented by the Solicitor.
5. Reports were heard from the following:
 - a. Recreation: The Easter Egg Hunt was a success, and sign up forms for tball and softball are now available. While the Koenig Field playground relocation project is still awaiting the DCNR contract signatures, a meeting did take place to discuss possible playground equipment.
 - b. Water Authority: The authority received its annual audit.
 - c. Manager's Report: The Borough manager said street sweeping resumed April 3rd.
