## Council Action Notes (CAN)

## April 15, 2013

During the Borough Council meeting on April 15, 2013 the following actions were taken:

A moment of silence was observed for the City of Boston, for all those who suffered, for all those who assisted in rendering aid, following the bomb explosions during the Marathon.

- 1. A motion was passed authorizing payment of bills for goods and services received by the Borough from the General Fund in the amount of \$38,289.65 and from the Sewer Fund in the amount of \$1,305.26 for a total of \$39,594.91.
- 2. Minutes of the following meetings were approved: Council meeting, March 18, 2013; Public Hearing, April 1, 2013; Council meeting, April 1, 2013.
- 3. Reports were heard during the business meeting:
  - a) General Government: The 2012 audit was received. A review with Maher-Duessel will be set up for Monday, April 22, 2013 at 9:00am with the General Gov't committee and Borough management. A review of this meeting will be presented at the Committee of the Whole, April 29, 2013.
  - b) Community Development will meet to discuss bike trail and dog park information.
  - c) Community Services: A playground equipment meeting was held. We are awaiting funds from DCED.
  - d) Solicitor: The solicitor attended a meeting regarding the issues of Memorandums of Understanding for the Wet Weather Feasibility studies and ALCOSAN's request for an extension to review the incorporation of Green Infrastructure (GI).
- 4. A motion was passed to request that the Civil Service Commission certify the top 3 eligible candidates of the current list as Council anticipates hiring a FT officer.
- 5. A raise was approved for Louis Sloan, having completed the 6 month probation and with favorable reviews, recommended by Borough Management.
- 6. A motion was passed to purchase a Toro MX 5060 Riding Mower from Penn Hills Rental under the State contract for \$3,279.00 (List price: \$4,199.00).
