Council Action Notes (CAN)

August 19, 2013

During the Borough Council meeting on August 19, 2013 the following actions were taken:

Items were entertained from the floor.

1. A motion was passed authorizing payment of bills for goods and services received by the Borough from the General Fund in the amount of \$26,337.26 and from the Sewer Fund in the amount of \$521.39 for a total of \$26,858.
2. Minutes of the following meetings were approved: Council meeting, July 15, 2013; Public Hearing, August 5, 2013; Council meeting, August 5, 2013.
3. Reports were heard during the business meeting:
 - a) General Government: The Committee has reviewed interest rates for loans for the Edgewood Street program. Current rates will be rechecked and sent to Council to be discussed at a future meeting.
 - b) Police report was given by Mayor Cook
 - c) Community Development: McDonald's is progressing in its review of Parcel D development.
 - d) Community Services: Will hold a meeting soon to discuss a potential dog park. A number of residents have come forth in support of this and are willing to assist Council in looking at what would be required. Community Day, August 24th is ready to go.
4. The third and final readings of Ordinance #1043 and was passed with a unanimous vote.
5. Resolution 2013-05 Act 44, regarding auditors was passed.
6. A motion was passed to continue the contract with Waste Management at the Option 1 year rates.
7. A motion was put forth and passed to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding between Edgewood and the Woodland Hills School District regarding police support. This motion was supported by Chief Payne having been discussed at the Council of Government Police Chief's meetings, and Mayor Cook.
8. A motion was made to suspend prohibition of alcoholic beverages for the Edgewood Foundation's Oktoberfest Fundraiser, September 22, 2013.
