M-7 Dr. Petrolla moved to approve the proposal from Pashek Associates dated May 13, 2014 to update the Edgewood Comprehensive Parks, Recreation and Open Space Plan. The total cost is \$10,000. Second by Dr. Wallace.

DISCUSSION: Ms. Schaefer said that updating the parks and recreation plan in order to consider the possibility of a dog park in Dickson Park was discussed during the Borough's budget process, and that the dog park idea is championed by many community members.

M-8 Dr. Petrolla made the first reading of the following Ordinance:

STORMWATER MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE BOROUGH OF EDGEWOOD ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA Ordinance No. 1051

Second by Mr. Fuller.

DISCUSSION: Ms. Bastianini said the ordinance was created in accordance with the Pennsylvania DEP MS4 permit requirements and in accordance with the Pennsylvania Storm Water Management Act. The ordinance is an update of the Borough's current storm water ordinance, and Ms. Bastianini addressed the areas of change.

This Ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the "Borough of Edgewood MS4 Prohibited Discharge Ordinance."

BUSINESS MEETING

VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT Mr. Fuller read Mr. Reynolds' report detailing the department's 60 calls for the month of February, and their plan for refurbishing the fire engine over the next three years.

RECREATION REPORT Ms. Bastianini said the Easter Egg Hunt would be held Saturday, March 28th at noon at Koenig Field. All area children age ten and younger are welcome to attend. She said 14th ward baseball sign ups were underway.

<u>WATER AUTHORITY REPORT</u> Mr. Fuller said the union filed a grievance about employees' contribution toward health care. He said pressure reducing stations were being discussed.

PLANNING COMMISSION The planning commission did not meet.

COG REPORT Ms. Schaefer said he annual COG dinner was held on Friday, February 27th.

<u>SOLICITOR'S REPORT</u> Solicitor Barry said he withdrew his candidacy for Commonwealth court. He discussed the issue of an undedicated alley in the borough that a resident inquired about. The borough never opened the alley, and Solicitor Barry drafted a letter at the resident's request stating that the alley was never opened, and as such the Borough has no right of access to the property.

BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT Ms. Bastianini said curbing would occur on McKay Street the following week. She described the heating problems that occurred at the Field House as a result of the extreme cold weather and said the claim had been turned over to the insurance company.

<u>NEW BUSINESS</u> Ms. Schaefer said there would be an ALCOSAN meeting on March 23rd for elected officials, managers, solicitors and engineers to discuss regionalization efforts.

Mr. Fuller moved to approve an Agreement between the Borough and CBS Films to use the upper parking lot of Parcel D for \$500 per day from March 2-March 4, 2015. Second by Dr. Petrolla.
